MR WONG: May it please your Worship. I still represent the
 defendant, and my learned friend Mr Kevin Cho for the
 prosecution.

COURT: Thank you.

MR CHO: Good morning, your Worship. The current situation is
 that the Department of Justice has reviewed the Psychiatric
 Report of the defendant prepared by the Government doctor,
 and the statement given by the defendant to assist the
 prosecution in their another on-going District Court case
 arising from the same investigation; and also the fact that
 the defendant had fully settled all the outstanding tax
 payment to the Inland Revenue Department. And I have taken
 instruction from the Department of Justice.

The prosecution now is offer no evidence against the
 defendant. And I also learn from Mr Wong there is no costs
 applications from defence.

COURT: Yes.

MR WONG: I confirm this, your Worship.

COURT: Yes. So the charge is dismissed on an offer of no
 evidence by the prosecution.

A COURT: ... that brings it all to an end. A


